

## Photo contest « *Bulles de bib'* »

### Competition rules

The libraries of TBS Education are organizing a photograph competition entitled “Bulles de bib’”. It will take place from January 30<sup>th</sup> to March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023. The participation to the competition, independent and free, is submitted to the conditions provided in this regulation.

#### **Article 1: Competition organizers**

#### **Article 2: Object of the competition**

The libraries of TBS Education give you the opportunity to show your artistic talents to their publics through this competition.

#### ***“Bulles de bib’”***

Do you feel calm and chilled in the TBS library? Do you think that the library is a place of well-being? It is time to show it with this competition! Come and take a picture in one of the libraries and show how they are a place of relaxation. Give free rein to your imagination and be creative: the most beautiful photos will be exhibited, and their author will get a reward.

#### **Article 3: Participation**

The competition is open to any natural person who is a member of TBS Education for the current academic year. The staff of the school is allowed to participate. Participants must have the rights of their work and accept its diffusion by the libraries.

Proposed works must not be against the laws and measures relating to public or private slander, insult, respect of privacy, image of goods or counterfeiting (of the copyright, brand or patent), human dignity, public order. Likewise, works must in no case encourage to violence, racial hatred nor realization of crimes of infraction. Works must be conformed to school rules. The libraries keep the right to exclude any work that do not respect these conditions.

In case the libraries reward the work of a participant who is not its author, and the real author manifest and turns against the libraries, the latter reserve the right to turn against the participant.

A single participation per person is allowed. Any fraud attempt will lead to the disqualification of the fraudster.

The participation implies the acceptance of this regulation.

## **Article 4: Proceedings of the competition**

### 4.1 Criterion

#### **“Bulles de bib”**

The photograph must be new. The participant must be the author of the photo and thus have the property law of the work. They also must have the authorization of identifiable people on the photo or the authorization of their legal representative if the person is underage.

- The image must be square
- The image must be entitled

### 4.2 Organization

The competition is announced on the website of the library and with posters put inside the libraries.

Works will be left in the libraries or on the website (<https://bibliotheque.tbs-education.fr/>). The printing will be done by the library. As a reminder, the participation is limited to a work per person.

To validate the participation, a registration form must be filled.

The participation to the competition implies the acceptance of the exhibition, diffusion, and exploitation of the work by the library.

Works that do not respect these rules will be eliminated. Thus, any incomplete or false participation will be rejected and will lead to the exclusion from the competition.

The libraries will take care of the exhibition of the works.

### 4.3 Calendar

- Opening of the competition: January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023
- Deadline for submission of works: February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023
- Exhibition: from February 20<sup>th</sup> to March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023
- Counting of votes: March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2023
- Communication of the winners: March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023

Subject to modification in the libraries' program.

## **Article 5: Winners' selection**

### 5.1 Selection criterion

A QR code will be available in each organizing library. TBS Education members could scan it and vote for their favorite work.

The authors of the works that will obtain the most votes before March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023, will be designated winners. Three winners will be selected.

Non selected works will be given back to participants and may be collected in the library where they have been delivered.

### 5.2: Communication of the winners

The winners will be contacted as soon as possible by the library via contact details given in the registration form.

The winners will be announced on the library's website.

### **Article 6: Rewards**

Winning works will be exhibited at the library from March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023, to March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023. The winners authorize the libraries to publish their works on site and on the website. The works selected for the exhibition will be given back later to the participants.

The rewards will be composed of:

- An entry to a spa + 1 book
- An essential oil diffuser + 1 book
- A head massager + 1 book

The winners will collect their prize at the libraries and with their TBS card on March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023, at the latest and on the opening hours of the libraries.

The reward can not be contested nor be given to someone else, nor be replaced by money, nor be replaced or exchanged.

The libraries reserve the right to change the nature or value of the rewards if necessary.

### **Article 7: Rights**

#### 7.1: Image reproduction right

Participants confirm to be the author of the work they submit. They guarantee that the works are original and new and that they have the utilization rights of the work.

By participating to the competition, the author let the libraries have the utilization right of their work (reproduction, representation, and adaptation) for 6 (six) months. Thus, authors accept that their work can be distributed and utilized freely on the communication medium of the libraries (posters, exhibition, website, social media).

Whenever the work is used, the author's name will be mentioned, in compliance with the respect of moral right. Within the scope of the application of their moral right, the author may ask for the withdrawal of the use of their work at any time. This will lead to the cancellation of their application.

The utilization right of the works submitted to the competition are granted in the context of non-commercial, cultural, and public reading and information of the libraries. Any commercial use is prohibited. These uses cannot give rise to a royalty payment according to the conditions defined in this regulation.

#### 7.2: "Informatique et libertés" law

In compliance with the French law "Informatique et libertés", information collected to participate in the competition are only addressed to the libraries. Collected data are strictly confidential and will not be used for commercial purposes. Any participant has the right to access, modify and delete their data on written request to the libraries at the following email address: [bibliotheque@tbs-education.fr](mailto:bibliotheque@tbs-education.fr). This opposition to the data treatment will lead to the cancellation of their participation to the competition.

### **Article 8: Responsibilities**

The organizing libraries could not be held responsible in case of:

- Possible external malicious act

- Destruction of information provided by participants for a reason not attributable to them
- Human, computer, electrical or other error
- Disruption that could affect the continuity of the competition
- Dysfunction of the voting process

The libraries keep the right to cancel the participation of any participant in case of non-respect with this regulation.

If the technical and/or administrative continuity of the competition is disrupted by a cause beyond the control of the libraries, the latter keep the right to interrupt the competition without any repayment or damages due to the participant.

**Article 9: Regulation deposit**

**Article 10: Acceptance of the regulation**

The participation to the competition implies the full and unreserved acceptance of this regulation, which is subject to French law. Its non-respect will lead to the cancellation of the participation.
